Very Important!

- ☐ Toothpaste & toothbrush
- ☐ Hairbrush or comb
- ☐ Deodorant
- ☐ Bug repellent
- ☐ Lip balm

Linens

- ☐ Sleeping bag or twin sheets
- ☐ Pillow & pillow case
- ☐ Blanket
- ☐ Washcloth
- ☐ Bath towel & beach towel

Optional

- ☐ Alarm Clock
- ☐ Hat or Visor
- ☐ Trash bag for dirty clothes
- ☐ Water Bottle

Clothes

- ☐ Shorts (at least 5inch inseam)
- ☐ Shirts (no crop or halter tops)
- ☐ Jeans/pants
- ☐ Jacket/sweatshirt
- ☐ Poncho or Rain Coat
- ☐ Pajamas
- ☐ Socks & Underwear
- ☐ Closed toe/heel athletic shoes
- ☐ Warm hat/scarf/gloves
- ☐ One extra set of clothes just in case

What NOT to Bring

- ☐ Cell Phone
- ☐ Any media or gaming device
- ☐ Jewelry
- ☐ Pocket knives, lighters or weapons
- ☐ Short shorts or mini skirts
- ☐ Food, snacks, drinks or candy
- ☐ Crop tops or halter tops
- ☐ Pets or animals of any kind
- ☐ Tobacco products, drugs or alcohol



Important Parent & Group Leader Kids Winter Blast Info

1. A \$50 non-refundable deposit per camper is required to officially reserve spot. All campers and adult leaders need to be registered online one month from camp.
2. Final balance for **church groups** is due by or before the first day of Kids Winter Blast, and it is due one week before for **individuals**. A full refund less the deposit will be given if any cancellation occurs. In the case of a cancellation, the \$50 deposit cannot be applied to another camper(s) remaining balance, but can be transferred if that spot is filled by a new camper.
3. No refund will be granted for a camper sent home for misbehavior, homesickness, or other reasons beyond the camp's control. No prorated fee is available for late arrival or early departure.
4. Check-in is at 5:00pm. Check-out will be at 10:30am on Sunday morning. Please have identification ready to show at check-out. The physical camp address is 10 Longridge Rd., Ridgeway, SC 29130. Directions can be found at www.camplongridge.com.
5. First meal served will be dinner on Friday. Last meal served will be breakfast on Sunday.
6. In keeping with our closed campus policy, no visitation is allowed while camp is in session unless approved by Camp Longridge administration. In case of an emergency, please call (803) 337-2082.
7. Campers are not allowed to use cell phones or any other media/gamming device while here at camp. Cell service is also very limited here. Incoming and outgoing phone calls from our office landline are reserved primarily for medical and/or emergency reasons.
8. In case of an emergency, we do have first aid and CPR certified staff on-site, and an EMS station is 2 miles from camp.
9. Camp Longridge staff and/or your camper's church leader(s) will routinely administer PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS ONLY. Please keep medication in original package that identifies the prescribing doctor. Place medication & additional instructions (if any) inside a clear, Ziploc bag along with camper name and church group (if applicable) written on it.
10. Dress is casual and modest. Campers will be doing experiential learning activities outdoor and will need to have closed-toe/closed-heel shoes.
11. The campers will be sleeping in cabins on bunk beds (single sized mattress). We do not provide linens. Please pack appropriate bedding such as a sleeping bag and pillow along with bath towels. Also, pack appropriate toiletries.
12. Our canteen and gift shop will be opened during camp so please do NOT pack additional snacks or candy. \$20 is the suggested amount, but please refer to our pricing list for the canteen and gift shop listed on our website for this decision. Please put money in an envelope with camper name on it. Campers are responsible for their own money at Kids Winter Blast. It will not be turned into Camp staff at check-in.
13. Please have camper(s) bring a Bible, pen, and notebook for our worship sessions.
