

Summer Camp Packing List

Very Important!

These items need to be turned in upon arrival at check-in OR to church leader if coming with group.

- Prescription Medications
(In Ziploc bag with camper name on it)

What NOT to Bring

- Cell Phone
 Any media or gaming device
 Jewelry
 Pocket Knives, lighters or weapons
 Immodest swimwear
 Short shorts or mini skirts
 Food, snacks, drinks or candy
 Crop tops or halter tops
 Pets or animals of any kind
 Tobacco products, drugs or alcohol

Clothes

- Shorts (at least 5inch inseam)
 Shirts (no crop or halter tops)
 Bathing suit (1 piece or Tankini-if it covers midriff)
 1 pair of jeans/pants
 Lightweight Jacket
 Poncho or Rain Coat
 Pajamas
 Socks & Underwear
 Closed toe/heel athletic shoes
 Cheap flip flops or sandals
 1 set of clothes to get messy
 Dark/camo clothes for night game
 Paintball clothing (**Teen Camp Only**)
 One extra set of clothes, just in case

Important Parent & Group Leader Camp Info

1. A \$100 non-refundable deposit per camper is required to officially reserve spot. All campers and adult leaders need to be registered online at least 3 weeks prior to camp.
2. Final balance **for church groups** is due on or before the first day of camp, and it is due for **individuals** the Wednesday before your week of camp. A full refund less the deposit will be given if any cancellation occurs. In the case of cancellation, the \$100 deposit cannot be applied to another camper(s) remaining balance, but can be transferred if that spot is filled by a new camper.
3. No refund will be granted for a camper sent home for misbehavior, homesickness, or other reasons beyond the camp's control. No prorated fee is available for late arrival or early departure.
4. Camp gates open on Monday at 11:00am for check-in. Please arrive as close to 11:00am as possible. Camp gates will re-open on Friday at 11am for check-out. The physical camp address is 10 Longridge Rd., Ridgeway, SC 29130. Directions can be found at www.camplongridge.com.
5. First meal served will be lunch on Monday. Last meal served will be breakfast on Friday.
6. In keeping with our closed campus policy, no visitation is allowed while camp is in session unless approved by Camp Longridge administration. In case of an emergency, please call (803) 337-2082.
7. Campers are not allowed to use cell phones or any other media/gamming device while here at camp. Cell service is also very limited here. Incoming and outgoing phone calls from our office landline are reserved primarily for medical and/or emergency reasons.
8. In case of an emergency, we will have first aid and CPR certified staff on-site and an EMS station is 2 miles from camp.
9. Campers love receiving mail! If you would like to send your camper a letter, please mail it to 10 Longridge Rd., Ridgeway, SC 29130. You can also bring mail and turn it into Camp staff at check-in. Camper mail will be handed out on Tuesday – Thursday of each camp week so plan accordingly.
10. Camp Longridge staff and/or your camper's church leader(s) will routinely administer **PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS ONLY**. Please keep medication in original package that identifies the prescribing doctor. Place medication & additional instructions (if any) inside a clear, Ziploc bag along with camper name and church group (if applicable) written on it.
11. Dress is casual but modest. Campers will be doing experiential learning activities outdoor and will need to have closed-toe/closed-heel shoes. The campers will also have lake time so please pack modest, one-piece bathing suits.
12. The campers will be sleeping in cabins on bunk beds (single sized mattress). Linens are not provided. Please pack appropriate bedding such as a sleeping bag and pillow along with bath towels. Also, pack appropriate toiletries.
13. Our canteen and gift shop will be opened during camp so please do **NOT** pack additional snacks or candy. \$40 is the suggested amount. Beginning Summer 2026, all Camp Store funds must be added to the camper's account online using a credit/debit card. We will no longer give cash refunds at the end of the week.
14. Please have camper(s) bring a Bible, pen, and notebook for our worship sessions.
15. Paintball is only offered during our Teen Camps. It is optional to play. Cost is \$20 per participant.
